

UVMTA SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION - 2011

Scholarship Auditions: Saturday April 30, 2011, BYU-I Campus, Snow Building (On approval of scheduling committee)

Application Fee: Senior Education Music Scholarship - \$15.00, Junior Education Music Scholarship - \$12.00

Scholarship Concert: Saturday, April 30, 2011, 5:00 P.M. (On approval of scheduling committee)

If you are planning on participating in the scholarship auditions, please reserve Saturday evening in order to attend this concert where winners will be asked to play one of their selections.

Junior Education Music Scholarship: Scholarships are available to all musicians who are in grades 8-11 at the time of auditions, and may be used for tuition toward a summer music camp, private music lessons, or music instructional materials. As many as twenty scholarships may be awarded. Each grade will be judged separately. Three winners from each grade with up to two Honorable Mentions may be awarded accordingly: 8th grade - \$100 (HM-\$50); 9th grade - \$125 (HM-\$60); 10th grade - \$150 (HM-\$75); and 11th grade - \$175 (HM-\$85)

Senior Education Music Scholarship: The Senior Scholarships are available to all musicians who are high school seniors at the time of auditions and may be used toward tuition at a college or university of choice, or toward private music instruction for college credit. A minimum of first, second, and third places will be awarded with first place a minimum of \$500, second place \$400, and third place \$300.

Audition Requirements:

- The student must be playing at least pre-advanced level music.
- The student must have participated in at least three UVMTA festivals. (not necessarily consecutively).
- The student's teacher must be an active member or active student member of UVMTA.
- The student must perform two memorized, original (no piano arrangements) pieces by different composers of contrasting styles or periods. Concertos (except piano concertos) are accepted with the same requirements as festival. (i.e. memorization for the organ is not required).
- Time limit for 8th-9th grade is 6 min.; 10th-11th grades - 8 min.; and seniors - 10 minutes.
- A scholarship winner may not audition for a subsequent UVMTA scholarship by performing the same selections with which the student has previously won. The subsequent solos must be different repertoire.

All Auditions will be live this year. Any exceptions will be approved on a case by case basis by the scholarship committee. Requests for prerecorded music can be found on the UVMTA website (UVMTA.org) and must be submitted by Feb. 26, 2011.
